Job Purpose:

Senior Officer - Environment and Public Health is a Mid-Level position at CPRD who will be mainly responsible for leading research and advocacy on the climate change-development-women's health nexus, report writing, and organizing study sharing and advocacy events under the scope of the project.

Key Responsibilities include (but are not limited to):

- Implementing research activities as required by the organization (data collection, analysis, and report writing)
- Developing research design, methodologies, and data collection tools
- Guiding Research Assistants in implementing research and other project activities
- Leading and monitoring data collection
- Communicating with the partners about the updates on project activities
- Developing periodic reports on the progress of the project implementation
- Planning and organizing dissemination, capacity-building, and policy advocacy events (study-sharing seminars, workshops, round table meetings, dialogues, press conferences, etc.)
- Collaborating in developing new project ideas and designing new project proposals on climate change and public health issues.

Education and Aptitude:

Master's in Public Health, Epidemiology and Biostatistics, or any related discipline from a renowned university with a minimum of 2 years of progressive professional experience as a researcher in the field of climate change and human health nexus.

Experience and Expertise

- **At least two (02) years of professional experience** conducting public health or epidemiology research using quantitative and qualitative methods in the fields of climate change, environment, and development.
- Experience in developing data collection tools (both quantitative and qualitative), conducting surveys and PRA, risk communication, and database management.
- Proven experience and proficiency in using relevant statistical packages (e.g., STATA, R, SPSS, NVivo, etc.) for data analysis is mandatory.
- Publications in peer-reviewed journals are highly expected.
- Clear theoretical understanding of climate change, disaster risk reduction, resilience building, etc., and respective national as well as global plans and frameworks is expected.
- Experience of conducting research activities in climate risk-exposed areas like coastal, char, *haor*, and *Barind* areas will be highly valued.

- Ability to prepare high-quality reports and present study findings to a wide range of stakeholders.
